<b>6 CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S REPORT</b> 6.1 <b>Farsley:</b> Following a meeting between League Chief Executive Officer Mark Heald, board member Brian Pearson and representatives of Farsley CC an agreement has been reached which was felt to be in the best interests of the Bradford Premier Cricket League and Cricket generally. The agreement was as follows: 1 Farsley's ban from cup competitions has been reduced to one year with the remaining three years suspended for two years. 2 Farsley will pay compensation of £1,500. 3 Farsley will be eligible to stage cup finals. 6.2 <b>Bradford &amp; Bingley:</b> Played an ineligible player in final second team game of the season. David Young and Mark Heald met with Bradford & Bingley officials when the facts were discussed. Mark Heald presented these facts to the full board, together with issues which were proposed as mitigating facts. The board then considered the issues and decided that rule 19 had been clearly breached and despite		

the mitigating factors raised that the penalty for breaching this rule should be applied. The 20 points they earned from the final game will be deducted with 10 points for playing the ineligible player. Their opponents Ossett will receive 18 additional points. This will mean that Bradford and Bingley second team will not be promoted and that Bankfoot CC will move in to second place and therefore be promoted.	MH	immediately
