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Management Board Meeting Thursday 8th June 2017

1 Minutes of the May Meeting. The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and accepted as a true record.

2 Matters Arising.

CricHQ: Some minor software issues with CricHQ remain.

Brook Walton: The club have still to pay their BPL subscriptions. Other issues include non-provision of umpire, non-payment for match balls and on-going disciplinary issue. Bob Schofield to visit club and discuss.

Methley v East Ardsley 2nd XI: Fixture now to be played on Sunday, June 25.

Windhill CC: Ground visit for pitch inspection concluded that the pitch had been too dry.

Cricket Heritage: Andrew Watson has inquired about the history of the CYCL.

3 Chief Executive's Report.

Pyramid: Meeting with Andrew Briggs, chairman of the Halifax League, resulted in a memorandum of understanding which will be ratified by the Halifax League at their meeting on June 8.

Clarification of Cup qualification rules: The eligibility of players has been restated by the CEO.

Premiership Criteria: On line Clubmark accreditation is now live and clubs are working on the requirements with a target date for completion of the end of July with club visits to be arranged as required.

Checks will be made over all Premier Clubs and those in line for promotion over having the required junior teams.

Discipline: Mr Loker's comments to be addressed by the CEO. General club discipline issues to be tackled.

DLS: This is still not fully understood by clubs and therefore a reminder of training and the DLS process will be issued before the weekend's fixtures. Umpires full understanding of rules is a concern - ongoing.

Umpires Reports: Comments received from several umpires regarding member clubs disciplinary actions - confirmation was provided that all umpire's reports are fully actioned and responded to.

Recent issues include a social media misuse matter, suspensions of two Idle CC players, an issue of dissent involving a Pudsey Congs 2nd XI player, a report of problems in the Azaad vs Brook Walton fixture is ongoing whilst several issues pertaining to the recent Cleckheaton v Pudsey St Lawrence fixture will require a full investigation. Finally, a disciplinary meeting has been arranged to deal with a report on the second eleven fixture between Hopton Mills and Scholes.

4 Chairman's Report.

The Brook Walton / Azaad cup fixture will now be hosted by Azaad CC. Arrangements for the T20 vs Yorkshire fixture are well underway.
