2. Minutes of the July 2018 Meeting and 3 Matters Arising

The minutes were passed as a true record with all matters arising being covered by the meeting.

4 Chairman's Report.

The Chairman wished to put on record his thanks for the many hours, members of the Board have had to 'put in' recently.

5. Chief Executives Report

There was no CEO's report due to his absence (on holiday)

6 Finance Treasurer Report

The Chairman informed the Board there is to be a full report at the end of the current season.

7. Secretary's Report

A 16-bullet point Report was handed out to all board members, a copy of which is to be available on request. The Report is also to be forwarded to those members of the board who were absent at this meeting.

Conversation ensued regarding each point with addition to each one as follows

- Congratulations to Keighley CC on winning the U19 Yorkshire T20.
- Position of Treasurer – In absence of a Treasurer the Chairman reported any o/s payments are 'ready to go.'
- **Farsley CC** were found to be in breach of Rule 37 on at least three occasions to date and are to receive a 30pt deduction, suspended for not providing a scorer for their 2ndXI Team games and a 10pt deduction for any further repetition.
- **Player Eligibility –Great Preston CC** asked for clarification of the grounds for the punishment for playing of LD Russell. These are to be provided and the points deduction stands.
- **Scholes CC** – due to the late cancellation of 2ndXI fixture v Spen Victoria CC and ongoing suggestion of insufficient players to fulfil remaining fixtures correctly the Board will seek to meet with Scholes CC chairman on the CEO's return from holiday.
- **Cup Finals** – Early indication of Board member attendance was sought.

- **NB World Cup 2019** – There was a discussion as to whether the league going to plan any additional Competition for Young Cricketers to take part in during August 2019? The Junior season will have finished at end of July but there is a golden opportunity to attract, recruit and retain the interest of Young Cricketers. Target Age Under 15/17? Matter to be discussed at future meeting.

8. Promotion/Relegation

- The Chairman confirmed that Clubs could now be notified of the situation re promotion and relegation. Email to be sent to all Clubs.

10. Umpires Association

Philip Radcliffe informed the meeting that there will be a Level 1 and 2 Course to be run and paid for by the League. This to take place at the end of September, dates to be finalised. Information and invitations to go out in the first week of September. Early indications are that some umpires are 'returning' to the BPCL which was welcomed by all board members.

11. Compliance/Premier League Criteria

- **Compliance** – A discussion concerning several Clubs ensued and Paul Bedford at the ECB is to be contacted to clarify/update/discuss 'our' criteria. The ECB are the only organisation that can accept change of Criteria for Clubs. Philip Radcliffe to contact Paul Bedford for update.

Meanwhile Letters have gone out to clubs who are considered to be required to clarify their current status and may not be compliant at present. Steve Archer (YCB) is required by the ECB to have 'signed off' all Clubmark applications by the end of October.

- Premier League Play Off semi-final will see our champions play the North Yorkshire South Durham League representatives at Scarborough on September 15.
- BPCL Umpires Steve Malone and Craig Chaplin have been appointed to the play-off panel.
