1 Minutes of the September Meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and accepted as a true record.

2 Matters Arising

Idle CC situation...monies and league laptop still outstanding with player registrations and any probable transfers "an issue". Brian Pearson to visit Idle CC representatives to obtain further clarity. Any other relevant items are covered by the meeting agenda.

3 Chairman's Report.

Gildersome and Farnley Hill CC: Gildersome to merge with Farnley Hill from the Dales Copuncil to form a new club called Gildersome & Farnley Hill. There are some player registration issues with Farnley Hill players to resolve.

Oulton CC: The 1st and 2nd XI fixtures scheduled for September 1st have been moved to September 15th.

ECB Request: The ECB have requested some information re BPL rule changes: Alan B to review and respond.

T20 game v Yorkshire CCC: This will be played on Monday, August 6. Pudsey Congs to be invited to host again.

A loan of monies has been made to Pudsey Congs CC to assist with the cost of new drains for the playing area.

CricHQ: The company has been bought by a new, New Zealand-based, company. The ECB has advised regarding playcricket and changes to their systems. The recommendation is that the BPL changes to playcricket who's system is free...Philip Radcliffe will "manage" the process.
